MEMORANDUM OPINION

Defendant was convicted in August 2024 of four misdemeanors committed at the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021, and thereafter received a presidential pardon on January 20, 2025. On August 4, 2025, the Court granted permission for Plaintiff—now representing herself—to file a second motion under Rule 33 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure seeking "relief from the judgment, vacating the conviction, or, in the alternative, a new trial," claiming one of the jurors was dishonest during *voir dire*. ECF No. 128 at 1. (As discussed below, her first Rule 33 motion, which also asserted misconduct during *voir dire* by that same juror, was denied on October 5, 2024, *see United States v. Young*, No. 23-cr-241, 2024 WL 4583101 (D.D.C. Oct. 25, 2024)). She has also filed a request "to unseal the name of the presiding juror," also known as the jury foreperson¹—whom she believes to be the allegedly dishonest juror—or, in the alternative, to provide her "a copy of the unredacted jury verdict form" filed on August 9, 2024, ECF No. 127; a motion for leave of court to file a bar complaint against that person, who is an attorney,
